Windsor round (and junior variants as appropriate)

Assembly at 11:00 AM, sighters shortly after.

40 minute break after the first distance, 15 minute break after the second distance.

Recurve, Barebow, Compound and Longbow categories. Medals awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each to Ladies and Gents. Junior medals will be awarded according to entries.

Entry fee of £6.00 per archer.

Archery GB rules of shooting will apply. The shoot is not Record Status, but scores at this shoot will be recognised by clubs and most counties for record purposes.

Field Captain and Lady Paramount or Lord Patron to be announced.

While the shooting ground is reasonably accessible by wheelchair and there is a ramp to facilitate access to the club house, the toilets are not wheelchair-friendly and may not be accessible to all wheelchair users.

Anyone wishing to take photographs or videos at the shoot must register with the tournament organiser on arrival. Members of the Phoenix Bowmen will take photographs on the day and may publish them on Facebook, the club's website, the club's newsletter, the Yorkshire Archery Association website and the Yorkshire Archery Association newsletter. If you do not wish to appear in any published photographs, please advise us on this form or on the day.

Please note that the pitch is primarily used for rugby, and all arrows must be found on the day. This means that we cannot allow the use of all-carbon or fibreglass arrows, since they are too difficult to find with a metal detector.

Data protection: Completed entry forms will be retained until the end of December 2019 then destroyed. The club secretary will make an electronic record of details provided on this entry form – this record will be securely deleted at the end of August 2018. The name, club, gender, age group and bow style of entrants will be published in the target list and results sheet, both of which will be made publicly available. The results sheet will include the scores achieved at the shoot. No other information requested on this entry form will be made publicly available. No record will be made of your payment details other than an indication to club members managing the shoot that you have paid.

Directions

We use the facilities of Halifax Rugby Union Football Club at Illingworth on the A629. This is approximately 2.5 miles from the town centre behind Moorside Junior School. The entry road, called "Holly Park Way", runs between the school and Moorside Garage.

The entry road is directly opposite the Moorside Club (formerly Illingworth Liberal Club). The postcode of the Moorside Club is HX2 8AR.

You may drive past Illingworth Sports Club, home of Illingworth RLFC. That is NOT our location – we're further down the road towards Halifax.

From Halifax town centre:

Take the A629 north towards Keighley. After about 2.5 miles, you'll see a sign on your right for Moorside Garage, just after a Tesco Express/Esso garage and a zebra crossing. Turn right into the road just before Moorside Garage and drive down into the grounds of Halifax RUFC.

If you pass a Morrison's supermarket on your left, you've gone too far.

From north of Halifax:

Get onto the A629 and follow it southwards towards Halifax town centre. Look out for a Morrison's supermarket on your right. When you pass it, continue straight on. After about 300 yards, you'll see a sign on your left for Moorside Garage, just before a zebra crossing and just before a school. Turn left into the road just after Moorside Garage and drive down into the grounds of Halifax RUFC. If you pass a Tesco Express/Esso garage on your right, you've gone too far.
